Hull Seaside Animal Rescue (HSAR) works with both domestic and feral cats. While the cats may appear docile, they may bite and scratch if handled. Do not handle any feral animals unless anesthetized.

These animals have unknown health history and should be presumed to be unvaccinated against Rabies. Bites, scratch and even less direct exposure can transmit rabies. Rabies immunization is required for all volunteers with Hull Seaside Animal Rescue. Vaccinated individuals agree to have blood tests every two years to determine whether a booster is needed for continuing protection.

I agree to comply with the spirit, policies and by-laws of HSAR.

I release HSAR and it's volunteers and facilities from any liability for any injury or damage which may occur while trapping, transporting or caring for these animals.
